Appointment for an examination at Diagnovum

Read everything you need to know

You will have regular contact with your general practice nurse and/or GP prior to receiving treatment. You will jointly discuss your state of health and steps you can take personally, while you may undergo additional examinations if necessary, or be referred to a dietician or podiatrist, for example.

Examination appointment

Your GP or general practice nurse may refer you for structural examination, such as blood tests. Your GP will refer you to Diagnovum in that case, as we are the collaborating healthcare provider in first-line diagnostics. We both take the blood samples and ensure you receive a letter informing you of the appointment. The letter posted to your home address bears the Diagnovum logo and that of your hospital, as shown below*. You may receive an appointment for a fundus photo/examination. The letter contains all the necessary information about the examination.

Blood sampling

If you receive an appointment to have blood taken at a Diagnovum blood sampling clinic, we would appreciate your bringing along both the letter and proof of identity. The phlebotomist will ask you to show these. We kindly request that you to come to have blood taken within two weeks of receiving the letter. An application on the phlebotomist's phone enables her/him to establish what kind of samples are required, based on your citizen service number (BSN).



* The appointment letter will arrive in an envelope bearing the Diagnovum logo and that of your hospital (see example opposite).



The examinations we perform are assessed, in the case of blood, by the hospital's laboratory and, in the case of a fundus photograph, by a hospital specialist. The results of your blood test can be viewed in your hospital's digital patient environment (MijnAmphia; you do need to create an account first). The results of your blood test and/or fundus examination can also be viewed by your GP and the specialist. If you are referred to the hospital afterwards, the specialist therefore does not have to repeat the examination.
